

WHAT ENERGY DATA SHOULD I PROVIDE?



At least 12 months.

Please provide as much breakdown as possible such as monthly or quarterly data, not just a single annual figure.



All main building utilities.

This could include electricity, gas, heating oil, LPG, gas oil or biomass.

If you have on-site generation like solar panels, provide generation and export data for this too.

You do not need to provide water, waste or transport data, but we might ask for it later if we think it is a major contributor to your carbon emissions.



Consumption data.

Energy bills, meter readings, or fuel invoices usually provide the information we need.

If you have a smart or half-hourly meter, please ask your supplier for half-hourly data as it helps us understand more about your usage profile.

If providing energy bills or invoices make sure you include the whole bill, not just the front-page costs.

If providing meter readings, send at least one recent bill for us to understand your meter type and current tariffs.

WHAT WILL YOU DO WITH THIS DATA?

We will analyse your data to estimate your current annual carbon emissions and begin to understand how your business operates. Our findings may influence what we ask you during the survey and help us provide the most practical and effective advice on reducing your energy consumption and carbon emissions.

If possible, we will also look at your current tariffs and charges and advise you if you might be able to get a better deal by shopping around.

All of our findings will be discussed with you during the survey and included in your decarbonisation report.
