Project Cost: £5,300
Grant Awarded: £2,100

Based in Bristol, Air Quality Consultants provides consultancy services on air quality management issues. Their leased office building is around 100 years old and struggles to maintain a constant comfortable temperature throughout the year. They have obtained grant funding to tackle this by replacing their boiler with a new highly efficient condensing unit, as well as improve and relocate their heating thermostat to a higher occupancy location. As part of the boiler install, all pipes in the boiler room have been insulated to minimise uncontrolled heat loss and further reduce gas usage.

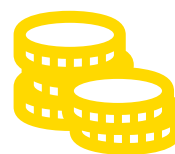
