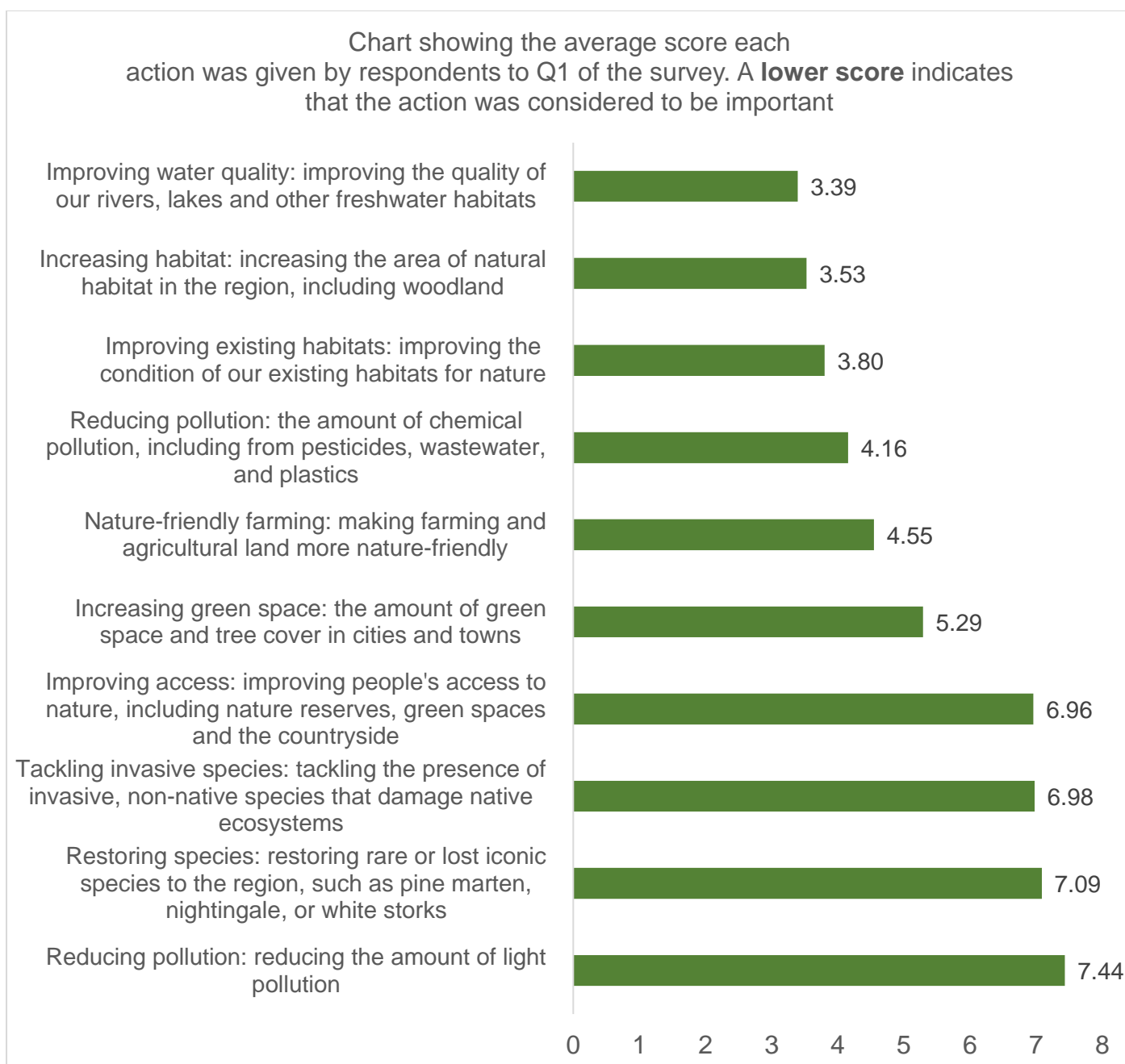
Appendix IX: Summary of responses to

Summary of responses to survey questions

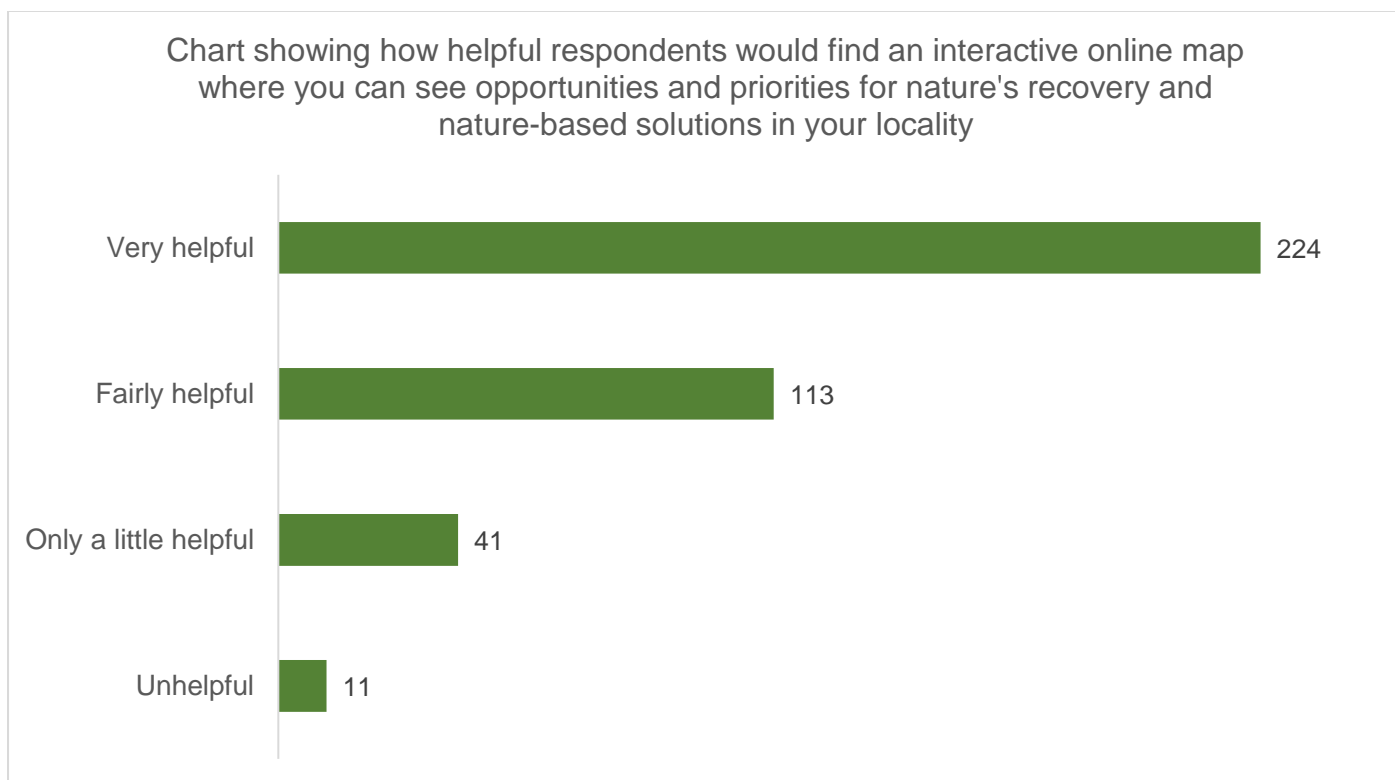

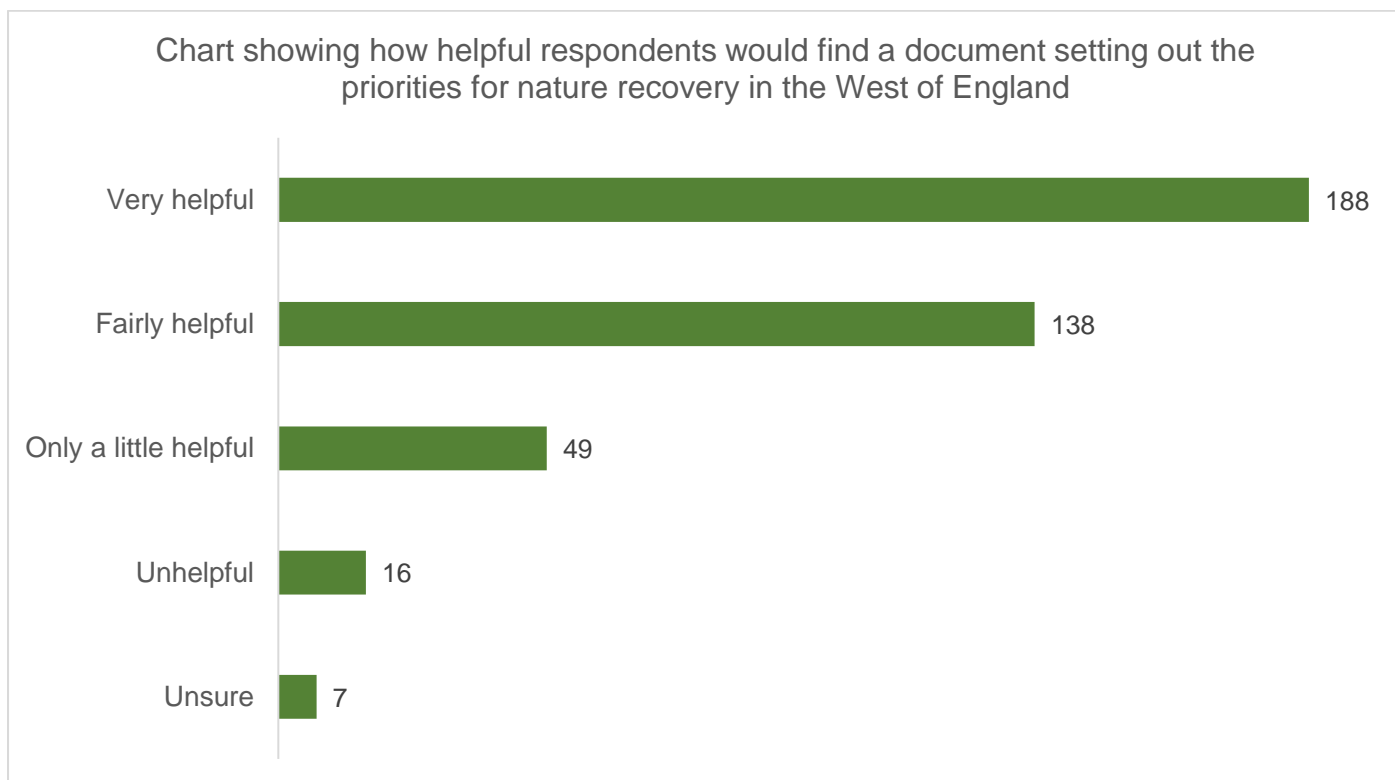

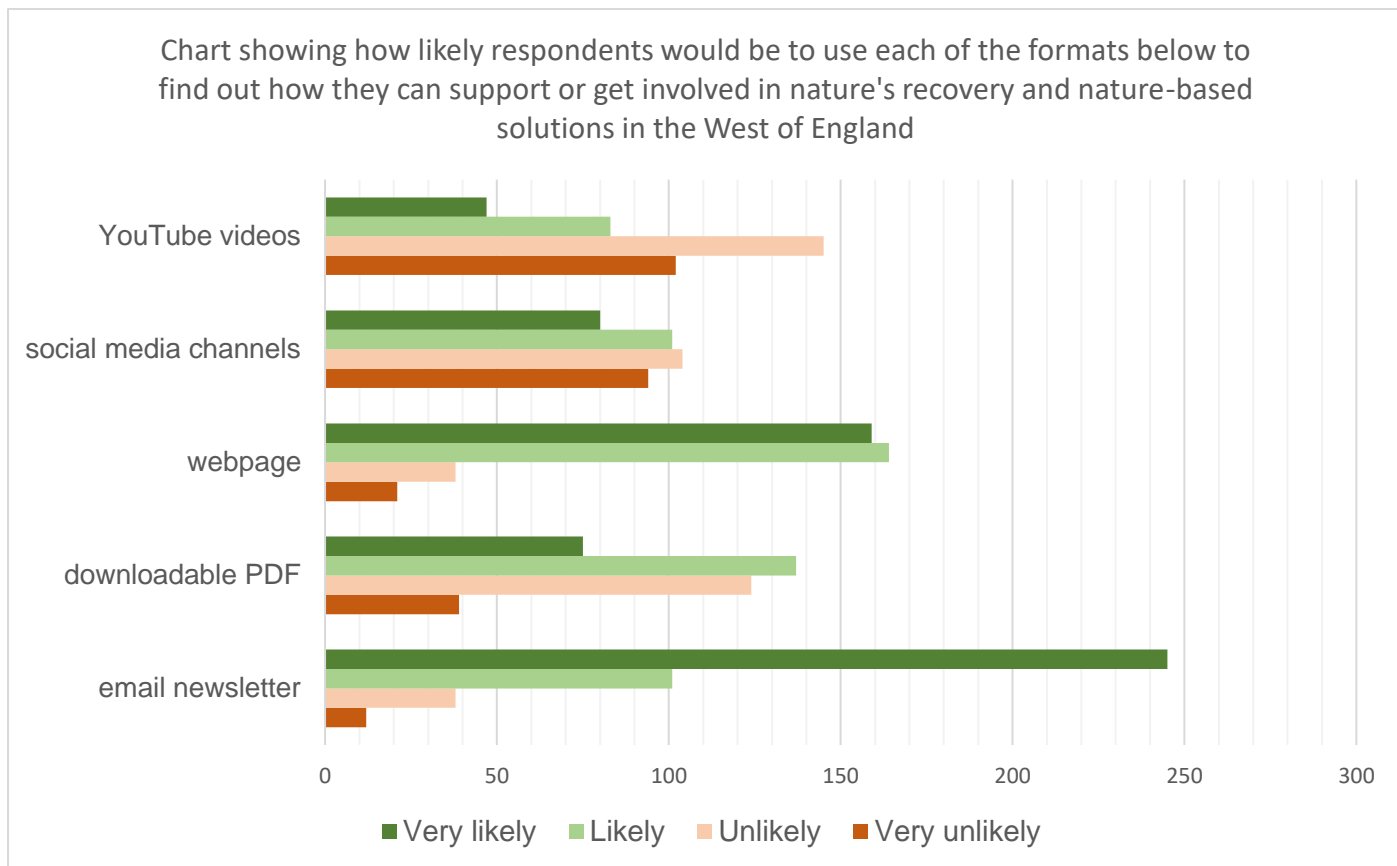
