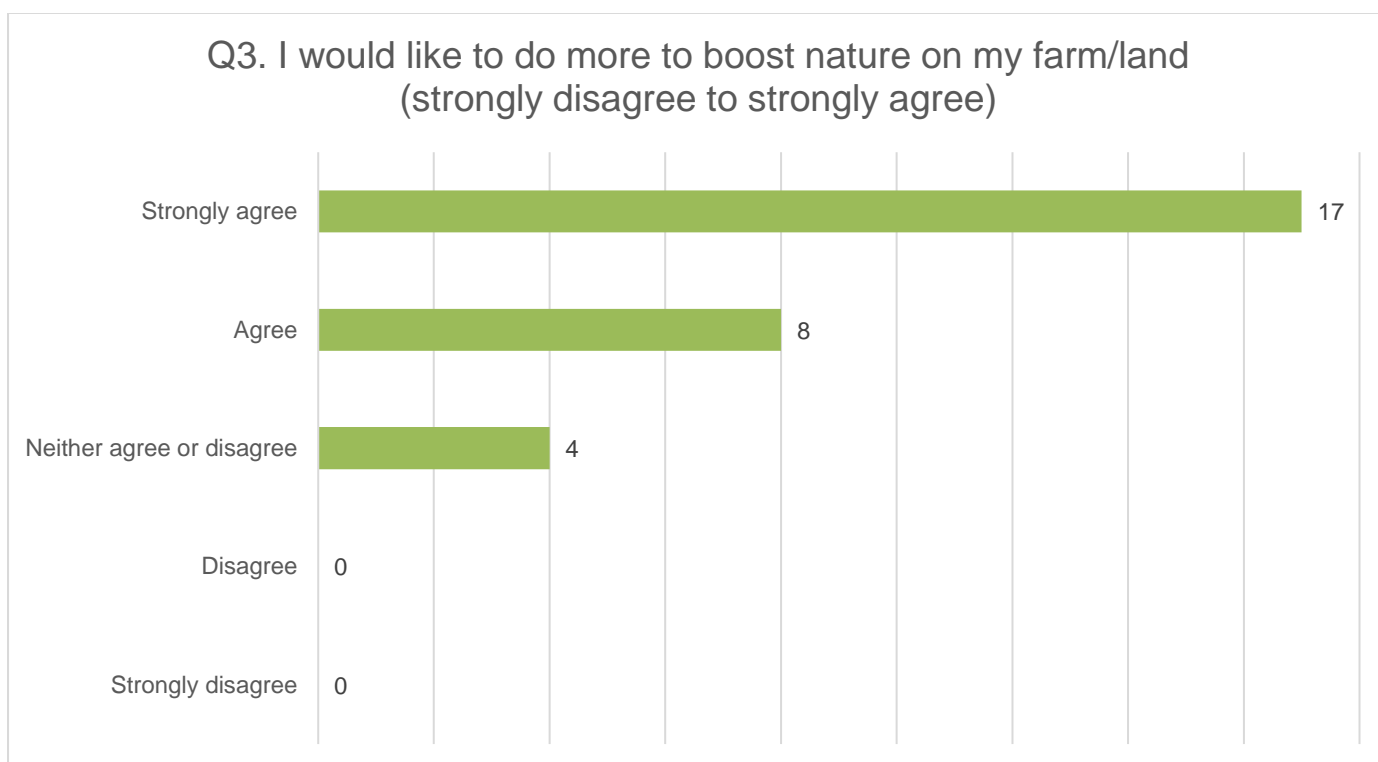
Context

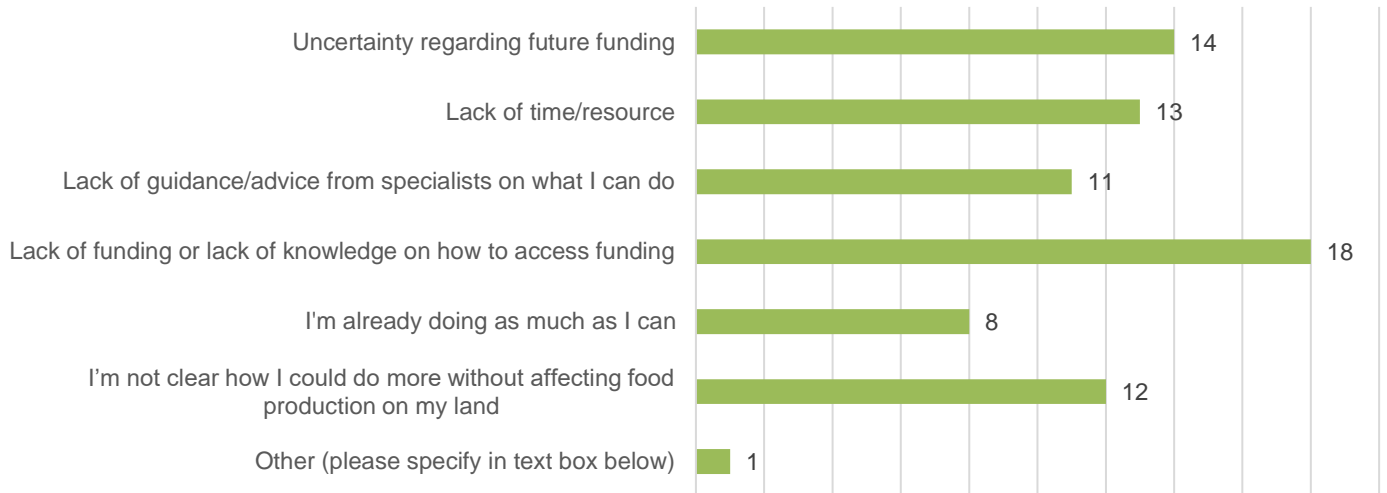
Answers to survey questions



Multi answer: percentage of respondents who selected each answer option (e.g. 100% would represent that all this question's respondents chose that option)



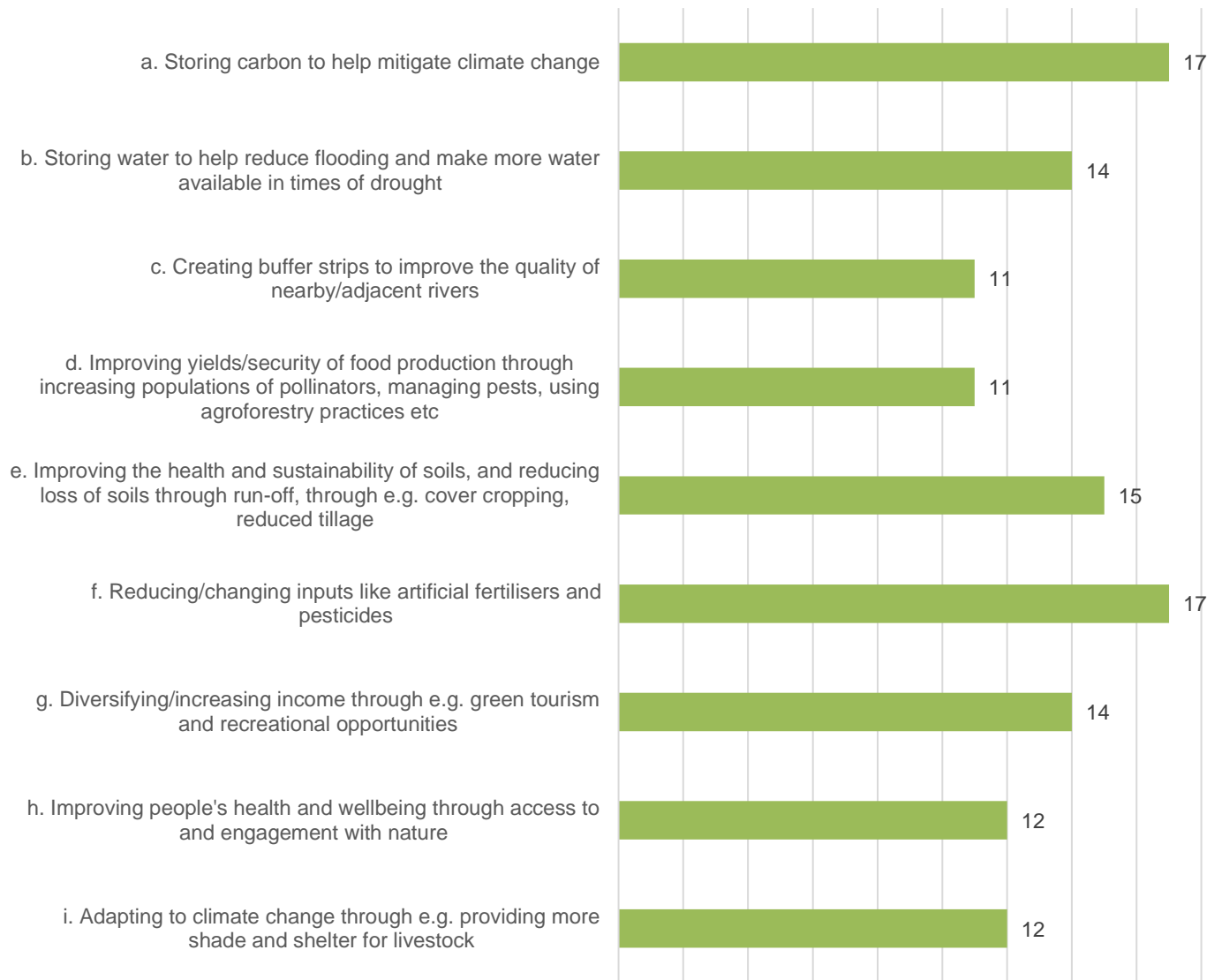

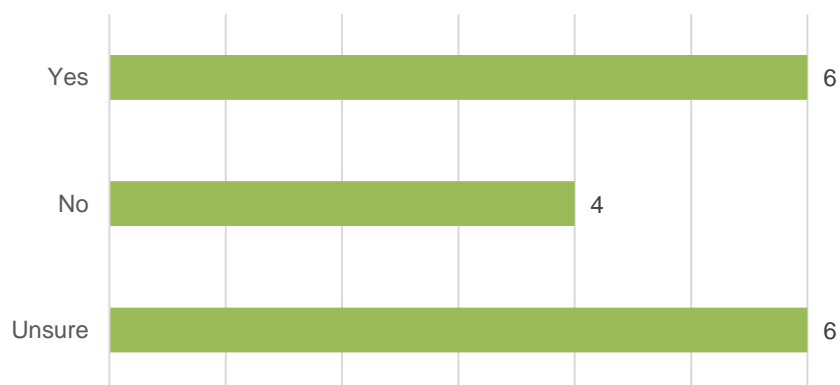

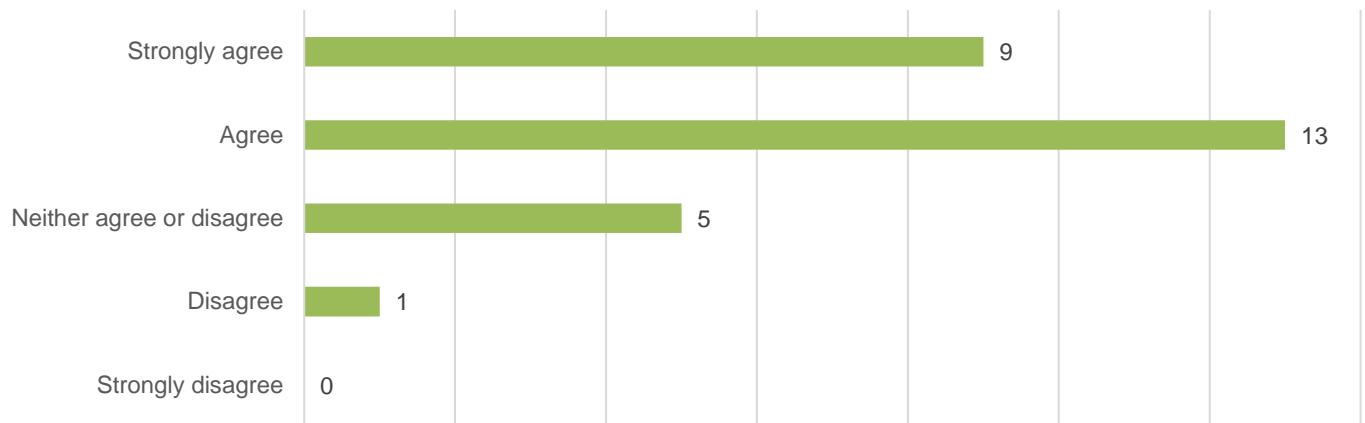
Q5. Do you know what the opportunities for nature-based solutions are on your farm?



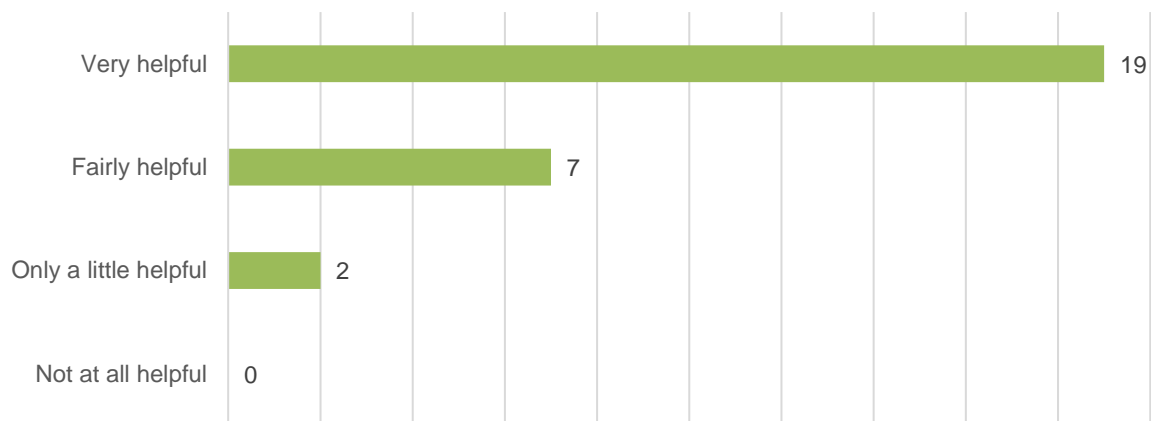
Q5.a. If no, would you like to discuss opportunities for nature-based solutions with an independent third party?



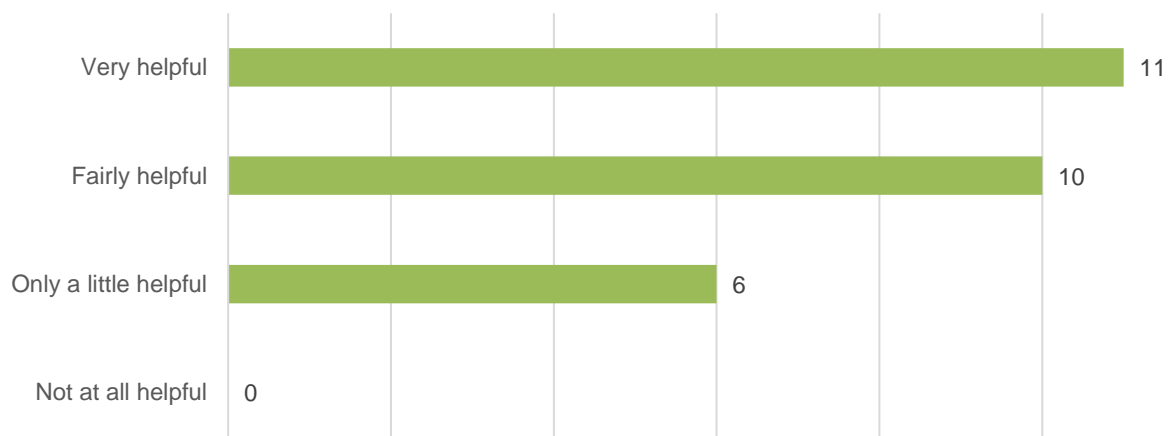

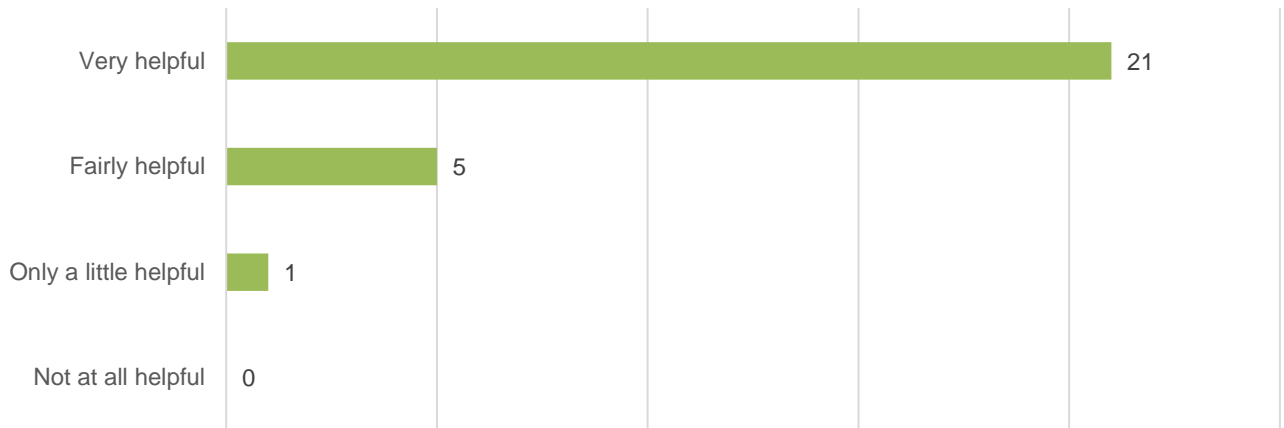
Q9. How helpful would you find an interactive online map where you can see opportunities and priorities for nature recovery and nature-based solutions in your area?



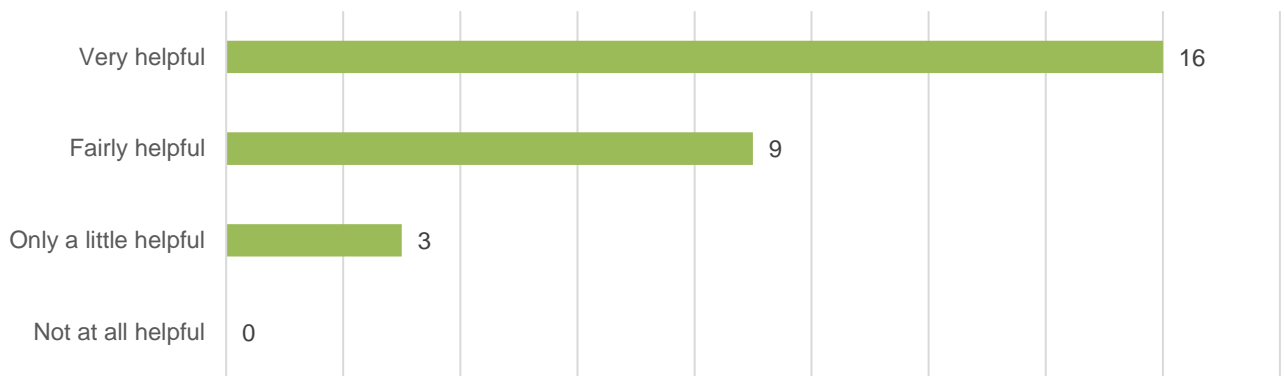
Q10. How helpful would you find a document setting out the priorities for nature recovery in the West of England?
